43rd Annual IPT Bull Sale To Lead Off 2011 Illinois Beef Expo

he 43rd Annual Illinois Performance Tested Bull Sale will be the lead off event of the 2011 Illinois Beef Expo. The sale is scheduled for 11 am on Thursday, February 24 at the Illinois State Fairgrounds Livestock Center in Springfield.

There are 110 elite performance tested bulls cataloged with 22 being long aged 2009 bulls ready for heavy use and 8 December through March yearling bulls. The breakdown of consigned bulls includes 60 Angus, 45 Simmentals, 4 Polled Herefords, and 1 Red Angus.

Bulls selling in the sale meet some of the most stringent requirements found in the United States. This is verified by only 464 or approximately two-thirds of the 711 bulls nominated during the past five years making it into the sale. Bulls are screened at nomination, for cataloging and during the processing for the sale.

The sale continues to be a leader in the em-

phasis on performance and carcass traits through the use of EPDs (Expected Progeny Differences). The 2011 sale index will place equal emphasis on EPDs for birth weight, weaning weight, yearling weight, maternal milk, marbling and ribeye area.
