

85th Dallas County Soils And Crops Conference Is Feb. 6

The 85th Annual Dallas County Soils and Crops Conference is 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 6 at the O'Bannon Community Center located on Ramsey Street in Buffalo.

"This year's conference covers several timely topics of importance to farmers and landowners," said Gary Naylor, a livestock specialist for University of Missouri Extension.

Topics this year include fertilizer costs and forage production, bio-security on the farm, ethanol from switchgrass, reviews of brush and weed control, and synchronized artificial in-

semination.

There will also be reports from the Lindley and Greasy Creek AgNPS Salt Projects, Farm Services Agency and the Dallas County Commission. Missouri Century Farm and Conservation Awards will also be presented.

O'Bannon Bank and Bank of Urbana will provide the beef brisket lunch.

The conference is an annual event sponsored by the Dallas County Extension Council, University of Missouri Extension and the Dallas County Commission.
