The Butler County University of Missouri Extension Council and the Ag Club of Three Rivers Community College have sponsored this annual event for twenty-three years. Admission is FREE.

There will be 118 booths available to visit and learn first-hand about agriculture and its importance to the economy. The expo will also feature outdoor exhibits. Twelve thousand people attended last year's two-day event.

The event will be held Friday, January 23 from 1 p.m. to 8 p.m. and Saturday, January 24 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Admission is free and the two days are packed with activities for the whole family. Entertainment and events include gospel, jazz, and contemporary music; agriculture seminars; beauty pageants; toy tractor pedal pull contests for youth ages 4 to 9; and a duck calling contest for youth and adults. There will be tractor driving contests for FFA members; petting farm; an old time auction; a milking contest; an ag photography contest; and baking contest. All events are FREE to enter except for the beauty pageant which is \$20 if prereigstered and \$25 if registered at the door.
