

Arkansas Cattle Grower's Conference Scheduled

HOPE, ARK.

Beef cattle producers will learn the latest production techniques to increase profits at the Arkansas Cattle Grower's Conference March 17.

The meeting, which opens at 10 a.m. with registration, is sponsored by the University of Arkansas Division of Agriculture.

The morning session begins at 10:30 a.m. with a tour that includes three stops: byproducts barn and feedlot facilities, ultrasounding cattle and pasture research.

In the afternoon, extension and cattle industry beef and forage experts will discuss forage management for calves, calf management and carcass quality and a market outlook for 2009. The program concludes at what 3:30 p.m. with a calf post-mortem examination demonstration
