

Delta Center Hosts Irrigation Field Day

An Irrigation Energy Field Day will be held at the University of Missouri Delta Center, Portageville, Mo. on July 28.

Registration begins at 7:30 a.m. and admission is free and open to the public. A catered lunch by Tasteful Creations also is free to those who print off a ticket when pre-registering on-line; otherwise the cost will be \$15 at the site.

The field day consists of three parts, including inside presentations, outside tours, and an irrigation trade show. Tour topics include: Lowering pumping costs; surge flow & PHAUCET lay-flat pipe design program; pivot rice; re-nozzling center pivots; and, using

weather stations and wireless sensors.

Indoor presentations will focus on funding opportunities for irrigation energy; guidelines for poly pipe; irrigation system safety; and wireless irrigation sensors. The field day will conclude at 1 p.m.
