

# Diamond Disk Introduced To The Delta

**H**olt Agribusiness, with stores in Sikeston, Mo. and Jonesboro, Ark. introduce the Summers Diamond Disk to the delta. Unlike X design disks, the diamond design provides a full cut the entire width of the disk, with no feathering blades. Since the Diamond Disk does not ridge, the unit, turning to the right or left, does not have to be raised at fields end, which could be of special benefit to track tractor operators.

Of particular interest to delta farmers might be the new 2510 DT model, specifically designed to handle high residue under wet conditions. Summers engineer, Pete Almen, accomplished

this by using shallow concavity notched blades with 10" Spacing. According to Almen, the low concavity of the notched blades on the 2510 DT worked above and beyond my expectations!

Nothing I did with the scraper design, matched the ability to go through wet high residue conditions like the 2510 DT.
