Compared to last week, feeder calves on light supply steady to firm and yearlings not well tested. Demand moderate to good. Supply light, mostly 400-600 lbs calves, near 36 percent steers and bulls, 38 percent heifers, 24 percent cows, 2 percent slaughter steers and heifers and 14 percent feeders over 600 lbs. Slaughter cows firm to \$1 higher.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1: 450-500 lbs \$126.50-128; 500-550 lbs \$120.50-126.50; 600-675 lbs \$114.25-119.75; pkg 765 lbs \$116. Medium and Large 1-2: 600-700 lbs \$112; pkg 745 lbs \$112.75; two pkgs 800-865 lbs \$109.75-110.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1: Pkg 385 lbs \$110.50; 400-500 lbs \$110-118, few pkgs fleshy/not-weaned 450-475 lbs \$100.25-100.50; two pkgs fleshy/not-weaned 575 lbs \$100.25-102.25.

Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg thin 398 lbs \$120.50; 400-450 lbs \$107-115.50, lot thin 450 lbs \$120.25; pkg 555 lbs \$113.50; pkg 665 lbs \$105.25.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1: 400-450 lbs \$122-129; 475-500 lbs \$114-120; pkg 540 lbs \$113.75; pkg 575 lbs \$108.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 70-80 Percent Lean, \$60-65, High Dressing \$65-69, few \$70-72, Low Dressing \$58-60; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$58.50-63.50, High Dressing \$63.50-67.50, Low Dressing \$53.50-57.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$48.50-53.50, High Dressing \$53.50-58.50, Low Dressing \$45-48, few \$40-45.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1300-2300 lbs \$65.25-70.25, High Dressing \$72.25-76, Low Dressing \$58-63.
