Receipts: 1168; Last Week: 3103; Year Ago: 1402

Compared to last week, feeder steers and heifers firm to \$2 higher, spots \$5-10 higher on 450-500 lbs heifers. Demand good. Supply light, mostly small packages of 450-750 lbs feeders, near 41 percent steers and bulls, 37 percent heifers, 22 percent cows and 12 percent feeders over 600 lbs. Slaughter cows firm to \$3 higher.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1 and 1-2: Small pkgs 400-500 lbs \$115-124.50; 500-600 lbs \$110-115; 600-700 lbs \$95-105.50; pkg 755 lbs \$95.25; lot 898 lbs \$87.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1 and 1-2: Small pkgs 400-500 lbs \$100.50-115.50; 500-600 lbs \$93-99.25, pkg thin 505 lbs \$106.50; 600-700 lbs \$84.50-94.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Small pkgs 450-500 lbs \$109.50-116.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 70-80 Percent Lean, \$48-53, High Dressing \$53-57, Low Dressing \$43-48; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$48-53, High Dressing \$53-56, Low Dressing \$43-48; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$45-50, High Dressing \$50-55, Low Dressing \$40-45.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1600-2200 lbs \$56.25-61.25, High Dressing \$62-63.50, Low Dressing \$50-55.

PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Heifers 22 head 950-1000 lbs w 100/200 lbs calves \$1500-1590, 29 head 900-925 lbs w baby/150 lbs calves \$1425-1560, pkg 800 lbs \$1390. Δ
