Compared to last week, not enough steers and heifers any one weight for adequate test, undertone weak to lower. Slaughter cows mostly steady. Demand moderate. Supply very light, mostly small packages of feeder calves, near 45 percent steers and bulls, 30 percent heifers and 25 percent cows.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1: Small pkgs 350-425 lbs \$191-199; small pkgs 475-525 lbs \$171-178.50; 575-600 lbs \$165.50-169; pkg fleshy \$158.50; pkg fleshy 710 lbs \$150.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1: Small pkgs 400-440 lbs \$171-180; small pkgs 450-500 lbs \$155.50-164; 500-550 lbs \$159-163.50, pkg fleshy \$156.50. Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 350 lbs \$182;

500-575 lbs \$152-160.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1: Few pkgs 425-450 lbs \$172-191; few pkgs 550-600 lbs \$155.50-161. Large 1-2: Pkg 785 lbs \$138.75.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 70-80 Percent Lean, few \$84.50-89.50, High Dressing Ind. \$94.50, Low Dressing \$79.25-84.25; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, few \$84.50-87.50, High Dressing Ind. \$92; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$82.50-87.50, High Dressing \$87.50-92.50, few \$94-97, Low Dressing \$72-82.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1450-2200 lbs \$99-106, High Dressing \$106.50-112.50.
