Compared to two weeks ago, undertone on a light supply of feeders firm to higher. Demand moderate to good. Supply light, mostly steers, near 60 percent steers and bulls, 15 percent heifers, 20 percent cows, 5 percent slaughter steers and heifers and 35 percent mostly steers over 600 lbs. Slaughter cows steady to \$5 lower, most decline on lean offerings.
