Compared to last feeder special, steers and heifers 400-500 lbs not well tested, steers and heifers 500-750 lbs steady to \$2 higher and over 750 lbs steady to \$2 lower. Demand good. Supply heavy on a calf and yearling special, outstanding quality with most offerings long-time weaned with shots, near 45 percent QSA verified, mostly 500-850 lbs feeders, near 51 percent steers, 42 percent heifers, 7 percent cows and 50 percent feeders over 600 lbs. Slaughter cows compared to last week, steady to firm.
FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1: Few pkgs 400-500 lbs \$114.50-115.50, few fleshy/unweaned \$104-106; 500-600 lbs \$100.50-118, pkg and lot blacks 515-520 lbs \$120-121.50; 600-700 lbs \$94.50-104; 700-800 lbs \$87.75-97.60; 800-900 lbs \$84.75-89. Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 530 lbs \$111.75; 625-700 lbs \$95.25-96.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1: Few pkgs 400-500 lbs \$94-105; 500-600 lbs \$88.25-96, pkg and lot thin \$99.75-100; 600-700 lbs \$85.25-95.25; 700-775 lbs \$84-89, lot replacement blacks 725 lbs \$104; fleshy 800-875 lbs \$75.25-80.25. Medium and Large 1-2: 500-600 lbs \$87-91.75; 675-725 lbs \$80.25-84.25.
SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 70-80 Percent Lean, \$46-51, High Dressing \$50.50-54.50, Ind. \$55.75, Low Dressing \$40-44; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, few \$46-49, High Dressing few \$51-52, Low Dressing \$37.50-44; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$38.50-43.50, Low Dressing \$33.50-38.50, few Shelly and weak \$25.50-32.50.
SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1450-2250 lbs \$50-55, High Dressing \$55.25-59.25.
SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS: (20 head) two pkgs Choice 3: 1250-1300 lbs \$77.25; pkg Choice Holsteins 2-3: 1375 lbs \$67.25.
