**Receipts: 895; Last Week: 1476; Year Ago: 780**

Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$1 higher, heifers sold \$1-2 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher. Cows made up approximately 10 percent of the run, 90 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 50 percent of the offering, 40 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 5 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$121-133; 300-350 lbs \$122-134; 350-400 lbs \$120-129; 400-450 lbs \$117-126; 450-500 lbs \$112-121; 500-550 lbs \$109-118; 600-650 lbs \$103-114. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$107-118; 450-500 lbs \$102-115; 500-600 lbs \$100-108.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 200-250 lbs

\$108-120; 325-400 lbs \$106-115; 400-500 lbs \$101-112; 500-600 lbs \$98-108; 600-650 lbs \$92-102. Medium 2: 275-300 lbs \$97-106; 350-375 lbs \$97-105; 450-500 lbs \$97-103; 500-600 lbs \$92-100.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 600-650 lbs \$97-107.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$52-57, High Dressing \$64; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$52-56, High Dressing \$60; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$47-52, High Dressing \$54.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: \$61-74.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth cows, 900-1100 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$750-900. Δ
