Compared to last week, feeder steers under 500 lbs were \$3-4 lower, heavier weights steady. Feeder heifers were steady. The bulk of the slaughter cows were steady, slaughter bulls sold \$2 higher. Demand was moderate to good. Supply of feeders was moderate with the supply of replacement cows and cow calf pairs moderate to heavy for this time of year. Recent scattered showers, of the "hit and miss" variety were mostly "miss" across the area. The lack of moisture and it's effect on the pastures was reflected in the number and quality of cows brought to the market. Cows and bulls made up approximately 28 percent of the run, 72 percent feeders. Steers and bulls made up approximately 54 percent of the feeder offering, 46 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 32 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1130-2450 lbs bulk \$90.50-102, High Dressing \$101.50-105, Low Dressing \$80.50-90.

STOCKER COWS: Few 2-5 yrs 835-1170 lbs \$80-93.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1: 3-5 yrs old 1150-1535 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage \$1150-1240 per head. Medium and Large 1-2: Six years to short and solid mouth 980-1465 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage \$960-1100 per head.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1: 5-7 yrs old 1100-1250 lbs with 200-250 lbs calves \$1360-1460 per pair; Medium and Large 1-2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth 900-1200 lbs with 100-150 lbs calves \$1025-1190 per pair. Medium and Large 2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth 750-1100 lbs with 100-150 lbs calves \$800-1010 per pair. Δ
