Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$5 higher, heifers sold uneven, rom \$5 higher to \$2 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply moderate. Cows made up approximately 11 percent of the run, 89 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 60 percent of the run, 89 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 60 percent of the offering, 35 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 34 percent.
