Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$2 higher, heifers sold \$2 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher. Cows made up approximately 2 percent of the run, 98 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 50 percent of the offering, 48 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 10 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$120-132; 300-350 lbs \$120-132; 350-400 lbs \$125-131; 400-450 lbs \$120-131; 450-500 lbs \$120-129; 500-600 lbs \$115-125; 600-650 lbs \$107-115. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$112-122; 450-500 lbs \$107-115; 500-600 lbs \$105-110.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 200-250 lbs
