**Receipts: 890; Last Week: 960; Year Ago: 820**

Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$3 higher, heifers sold \$3 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher. Cows made up approximately 10 percent of the run, 90 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 50 percent of the offering, 40 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 10 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$122-140; 300-350 lbs \$120-139; 350-400 lbs \$120-138; 400-450 lbs \$118-126; 450-500 lbs \$115-124; 500-600 lbs \$110-121; 600-650 lbs \$107-115. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$112-120; 450-500 lbs \$110-115; 500-600 lbs \$107-112.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 200-250 lbs

\$110-120; 325-400 lbs \$107-115; 400-500 lbs \$105-112; 500-600 lbs \$100-111; 600-650 lbs \$98-108. Medium 2: 275-300 lbs \$100-110; 350-375 lbs \$100-108; 450-500 lbs \$98-107; 500-600 lbs \$97-103.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 600-650 lbs \$98-106.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$55-59, High Dressing \$61; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$56-61, High Dressing \$64; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$47-51, High Dressing \$56.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: \$62-74.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth cows, 900-1100 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$725-910. Δ
