**Receipts: 901; Last Week: 660; Year Ago: 1345**

Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$3 higher, heifers sold \$3 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher. Cows made up approximately 5 percent of the run, 95 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 40 percent of the offering 45 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 10 percent.

**FEEDER STEERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$110-122; 300-350 lbs \$110-121; 350-400 lbs \$110-121; 400-450 lbs \$110-120; 450-500 lbs \$105-118; 500-600 lbs \$100-112; 600-650 lbs \$95-102. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$100-110; 450-500 lbs \$97-105; 500-600 lbs \$90-100.

**FEEDER HEIFERS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 200-250

lbs \$100-110; 325-400 lbs \$92-102; 400-500 lbs \$89-97; 500-600 lbs \$88-95; 600-650 lbs \$85-93. Medium 2: 275-300 lbs \$85-92; 350-375 lbs \$85-92; 450-500 lbs \$85-92; 500-600 lbs \$80-85.

**FEEDER BULLS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 600-650 lbs \$87-94.

**SLAUGHTER COWS:** Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$48-52, High Dressing \$55; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$47-51, High Dressing \$54; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$42-49, High Dressing \$52.

**SLAUGHTER BULLS:** Yield Grade 1-2: \$58-64.

**REPLACEMENT COWS:** Medium and Large 1-2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth cows, 900-1100 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$800-925. Δ
