Receipts: 1148; Last Week: 1411; Year Ago: n/a Compared to last week, in a lightly tested market feeders sold lower. Three hundred and four hundred weight feeder steers took the hardest hit finishing \$15-20 lower. Heavier weight steers tried to rally several times during the day but finished the day \$3-5 lower. Feeder heifers were mixed, \$3 lower to \$3 higher, driven mostly by condition and quality, with weaned and vaccinated heifers quickly absorbed by the buyers. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady. Cow/calf pairs and slaughter cows seemed to dominate the sale ring as continued dry conditions are forcing producers in the area to cut even deeper into their herds. Demand was good throughout the sale with a light supply of feeders and a heavy offering of slaughter, breed and cow/calf pairs. Cows made up approximately 35 percent of the run, 65 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 45 percent of the feeder offering, 50 percent heifers and 5 percent bulls. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 28 percent.
