Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$2 higher, heifers sold \$3 higher and slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher. Cows made up approximately 5 percent of the run, 95 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 45 percent of the offering, 40 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 10 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$120-130; 300-350 lbs \$122-130; 350-400 lbs \$118-125; 400-450 lbs \$115-121; 450-500 lbs \$108-120; 500-600 lbs \$100-114; 600-650 lbs \$88-98. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$105-112; 450-500 lbs \$95-105; 500-600 lbs \$90-100.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 200-250 lbs

\$110-115; 325-400 lbs \$100-110; 400-500 lbs \$95-104; 500-600 lbs \$85-94; 600-650 lbs \$82-89. Medium 2: 275-300 lbs \$90-100; 350-375 lbs \$87-95; 450-500 lbs \$87-91; 500-600 lbs \$80-86.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: 600-650 lbs \$85-92.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$46-50, High Dressing \$54; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$45-49, High Dressing \$50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$40-45, High Dressing \$48.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: \$50-56.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth cows, 900-1100 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$650-825. Δ
