Receipts: 1001; Last Week: 870; Year Ago: 950

Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$5 higher, heifers sold \$3 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$4 higher. Cows made up approximately 5 percent of the run, 95 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 50 percent of the offering, 45 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 20 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$120-129; 300-350 lbs \$120-127; 350-400 lbs \$115-125; 400-450 lbs \$112-122; 450-500 lbs \$110-119; 500-600 lbs \$105-118; 600-650 lbs \$100-110. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$110-115; 450-500 lbs \$105-110; 500-600 lbs \$100-105.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 200-250 lbs

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: 600-650 lbs \$92-100.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$48-53, High Dressing \$55; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$49-54, High Dressing \$56; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$40-46, High Dressing \$48.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: \$55-65.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth cows, 900-1100 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$700-925. Δ
