Receipts: 1050; Last Week: 875

Compared to last week, steers sold steady to \$4 lower, heifers sold \$3-5 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 lower. Cows made up approximately 10 percent of the run, 90 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 40 percent of the offering, 60 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 5 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$110-125; 300-350 lbs \$110-120; 350-400 lbs \$110-120; 400-450 lbs \$107-115; 450-500 lbs \$105-112; 500-600 lbs \$98-105; 600-650 lbs \$95-102. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$95-105; 450-500 lbs \$95-105; 500-600 lbs \$92-100.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 200-250 lbs

\$100-115; 325-400 lbs \$92-106; 400-500 lbs \$90-102; 500-600 lbs \$85-93; 600-650 lbs \$82-89. Medium 2: 275-300 lbs \$85-95; 350-375 lbs \$85-95; 450-500 lbs \$85-92; 500-600 lbs \$80-85.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: 600-650 lbs \$85-92.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$46-50, High Dressing \$52; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$47-49, High Dressing \$50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$40-45, High Dressing \$46.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: \$52-58.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 5 yrs to short and solid mouth cows, 900-1100 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$675-900. Δ
