Compared to last week, steers and heifers under 600 lbs sold \$3-12 lower, the cattle over 600 lbs sold steady to \$2 lower. Corn going up and the grass is gone makes for a weak cattle market. The dry weather and next week being a holiday brought in a two weeks supply of cattle with cows and bulls making up 492 of the offering. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady to \$1 lower; Demand light and supply moderate. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 55 percent of the offering, 38 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 30 percent.
