Compared to last week, steers over 700 lbs and the heifer offering sold \$2-6 higher, the rest of the steers offering sold \$4-5 lower. A large percent of the feeders were sold in large lots over 600 lbs. Slaughter cows sold \$2 lower and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 10 percent of the run, 90 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 38 percent of the offering, 54 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 59 percent.
