Compared to last week, 500 lb steers sold steady, the rest of the offering sold \$3-7 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$6 lower; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 21 percent of the run, 79 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 42 percent of the offering, 48 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 27 percent.
