Receipts: 719; Last Week: No Sale; Year Ago: 931

Compared to three weeks ago, the last sale of the year, feeder steers and heifers \$6-9 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls \$2 lower; demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 27 percent of the run, 73 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 47 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 22 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$101-110; 300-400 lbs \$100-110.50; 400-450 lbs \$98-105; 450-500 lbs \$89-95.25; 500-600 lbs \$85.25-98.25; 600-700 lbs \$80-90; 700-750 lbs \$81.75-82.50. Medium 2: 400-500 lbs \$80-95.50; 500-600 lbs \$75.50-85.75; 600-700 lbs \$75-84.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 305 lbs \$95.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 300-400 lbs \$85-95; 400-500 lbs \$82.25-90; 500-600 lbs \$79-85.25; 600-700 lbs \$75.25-85; 700-725 lbs \$80-90. Medium 2: Few 300-400 lbs \$72-90; few 400-450 lbs \$75-81; few 600-700 lbs \$70.50-75.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: 525-600 lbs \$87-87.50; pkg 615 lbs \$75.25; 725-750 lbs \$65-70.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$42.50-46.75, High Dressing \$48-49; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$42.75-47.50, High Dressing \$50.50, Low Dressing \$38; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$31-35, High Dressing \$40.25, Low Dressing \$23.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1340-2155 lbs \$50.25-52.25, High Dressing \$56.25

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 845-1335 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$630-810.
