Due to the Independence Day holiday there was no sale last week, however compared to two weeks ago feeder steers and heifers sold \$3-5 higher in a lightly tested market. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady. Supply was light as the triple digit heat indices kept most livestock at home seeking shade or a deep hole of water. Demand was moderate. Slaughter and bred cows made up 36 percent of the offering. The feeder supply included 45 percent steers, 17 percent bulls and 38 percent heifers. Near 13 percent of the feeder run weighed over 600 lbs.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 980-1825 lbs, \$76-84.50, High Dressing Individual \$90.25, Low Dressing \$61-75.25.

FEEDER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

BRED COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old 1020-1265 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage \$875-925. Medium and Large 2: 3-7 yrs 1030-1130 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage \$650-725.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-6 yrs 925-1100 lbs with 100-150 lbs calves \$990-1225 per pair. Δ
