Receipts: 521; Last Week: 624; Year Ago: 421

Compared to last week, 300 lbs steers and heifers sold \$2-5 higher, the rest of the offering sold uneven, from \$1 higher to \$3 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$6 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 27 percent of the run, 73 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 35 percent of the offering, 52 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 17 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1700-2025 lbs bulk \$66-70, Low Dressing \$61.50-62.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs, 925-1210 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$690-985.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 920-1235 lbs with 95-210 lbs calves, \$780-1060 per pair. Δ
