Receipts: 469; Last Week: 582; Year Ago: 745

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$4-8 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 lower; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 42 percent of the offering, 52 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 13 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 325-375 lbs \$107-112.50; 400-500 lbs \$100-111.50; 525-600 lbs \$104-105; 600-650 lbs \$94-100.50; few 700-750 lbs \$85-96.50. Medium 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$89-100; 400-500 lbs \$91.50-100; pkg 683 lbs \$84.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1240-1890 lbs, Bulk \$63-64.25.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 4-7 yrs old, 1075-1315 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$810-960.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 6 yrs old, 1090-1345 lbs, with 90-140 lbs calves, \$1100 per pair.
