Compared to last week, 400-500 lbs steers sold \$5 higher, the rest of the offering sold steady to \$2 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 12 percent of the run, 88 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 39 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 11 percent.
