Due to no sale last week there was no trend comparison, however compared to two weeks ago steers and heifers had undertones of \$5-8 higher. Slaughter cows sold steady, bulls sold \$2 higher on a light test; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 28 percent of the run, 72 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 36 percent of the offering, 60 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 14 percent.
