Extreme drought, very spotty rain, and general prospects for crop conditions not good are driving the market lower. Quality and condition of many animals are deteriorating. The good quality feeder cattle held their price. Market overall trended \$1-9 lower. We are still seeing high numbers of cows hitting the market \$8-10 lower. Breeding stock cows steady.
