Compared to last week, steers over 600 lbs sold steady the rest of the offering sold \$4-6 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls steady; Demand good and supply light. Cows made up approximately 8 percent of the run, 92 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 43 percent of the offering, 53 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 35 percent.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: 500-550 lbs \$90-93.50; 600-675 lbs \$89-98.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$56.75-59.25, High Dressing \$60; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$53.50-58.75, High Dressing \$61.25-62, Low Dressing \$49.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, Scarce.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1680-1830 lbs, Bulk \$68.50-71.25.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 915-1285 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$560-765.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 975-1270 lbs with 75-180 lbs calves, \$940-990 per pair.
