Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, \$2 higher to \$3 lower. Slaughter cows \$1 lower, bulls scarce; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 10 percent of the run, 90 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 38 percent of the offering, 52 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 26 percent.
