There will be no sale at Fruitland (May 26; June 30; July 28)

Compared to last week, 300 lbs steers and heifers sold \$5-10 higher, 400 lbs steers and heifers sold \$2 lower, the rest of the offering sold steady to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 22 percent the run, 78 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 52 percent of the offering, 42 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 22 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1355-1875 lbs bulk \$58.50-60, High Dressing \$63.25, Low Dressing \$50.25.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 890-1235 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$560-720. 8 short and solid mouth, 890-1310 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$490-660.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 2-6 yrs old, 980-1230 with 90-270 lbs calves, \$880-920 per pair.
