No Sale July 8 due to the Holidays. Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$2-5 lower on a limited test. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher, bulls sold steady; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 35 percent of the run, 65 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 41 percent of the offering, 53 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 16 percent.
