Receipts: 648; Last Week: 722; Year Ago: 402

Compared to last week, steers and heifers under 500 lbs sold \$2-4 lower, the rest of the offering sold \$1-5 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 28 percent of the run, 78 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 50 percent of the offering, 42 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 22 percent.

Medium 2: 400-500 lbs \$94-102; 500-525 lbs \$90.50-93; pkg 640 lbs \$85; few 700-750 lbs \$80-83.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 398 lbs \$72.50; pkg 471 lbs \$65.25.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 250-300 lbs \$114-116; 300-400 lbs \$107-116; 400-500 lbs \$101-107.50;

500-550 lbs \$101-106; 550-600 lbs \$92-96.50; 650-675 lbs \$87.75-94.50; pkg 765 lbs \$82.75; pkg 840 lbs \$80.25. Medium 2: 300-400 lbs \$90-101; 400-450 lbs \$92-100; 500-600 lbs \$80.50-95; 600-700 lbs \$72.50-86.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 500-550 lbs \$97-106; few 600-650 lbs \$90.50-91.50; few 700-725 lbs \$79-86.50.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, \$47.75-54, High Dressing \$55-59.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$47.25-52.75, High Dressing \$54.25-56.50, Low Dressing \$40.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, \$38.50-45.25, High Dressing \$47.25, Low Dressing \$33.50.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1235-1900 lbs \$56.50-62, High Dressing \$65, Low Dressing \$54.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 5-7 yrs old, 950-1320 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$610-850.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.
