Compared to last week, 400 lbs steers and heifers sold \$2 higher, the rest of the offering sold \$1-3 lower on a limited test. Slaughter cows sold \$2 lower and bulls sold \$4 lower; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 30 percent of the run, 70 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 39 percent of the offering, 46 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 32 percent.
