Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$3-5 higher, except 300-475 lbs heifers they sold \$3-5 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and buls sold \$4 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 18 percent of the run, 82 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 54 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 24 percent.
