Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold steady to \$4 lower with very poor quality in the offering. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls sold higher; Demand and supply light Cows made up approximately 21 percent of the run, 79 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 36 percent of the offering, 54 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 23 percent.
