Receipts: 668; Last Week: 557; Year Ago: 797

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$3-7 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1 higher; Demand moderate and supply light. Cows made up approximately 18 percent of the run, 82 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 51 percent of the offering, 44 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 30 percent.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-7 yrs old, 940-1320 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$750-830. 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 915-1310 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$485-605.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: 3-6 yrs old, 895-1345 lbs with 85-160 lbs calves, \$890-1000 per pair. Δ
