Compared to last week, 300 lbs steers sold steady, the rest of the offering sold \$2-6 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 22 percent of the run, 78 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 36 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 15 percent.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Very few 1405-1725 lbs bulk \$79.50-83.75, Low Dressing \$64.50-68.50.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 2: Few 5-6 yrs old, 905-1165 lbs \$67.50-70.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium 2: Few 6 yrs to short and solid mouth, 935-1140 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$740-960.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 2: Very few 4-6 yrs old, 980-1215 lbs with 80-130 lbs calves, \$925-1200 per pair. Δ
