Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$4-8 lower on a poor quality offering. Slaughter cows sold \$1 lower and bulls sold \$3 lower; Demand and supply light. Bought calves are getting sick and buyers are mainly interested in weaned and vaccinated calves. Cows made up approximately 16 percent of the run, 84 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 25 percent of the offering, 60 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 12 percent.
