Receipts: 456; Last Week: 456; Year Ago: 404

Compared to last week, 400-600 lbs steers and heifers sold steady to \$4 higher; the rest of the offering sold \$3-5 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 46 percent of the offering, 48 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 7 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Pkg 262 lbs \$134; few 300-400 lbs \$120-127; 400-450 lbs \$120-130; few 450-500 lbs \$124-135.50; 500-550 lbs \$119-129; 550-600 lbs \$116-119; pkg 667 lbs \$115; pkg 732 lbs \$110.25. Medium 2: Few 325-400 lbs \$110-118; 400-500 lbs \$110-120.50; few 500-525 lbs \$103-110.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Few 650-700 lbs \$65.25-71.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-

275 lbs \$121-124; 300-400 lbs \$108-117.50; 400-500 lbs \$112-122.50; few 500-575 lbs \$100-111.50; few 600-650 lbs \$100-100.50. Medium 2: Pkg 355 lbs \$100.50-113; few 400-500 lbs \$99-110; few 550-600 lbs \$90-95.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 550-600 lbs \$105-109.75.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$57-60.25, High Dressing few \$62-65; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$54-59.50, High Dressing \$60.50-61.25; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$45.25-53.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1180-1455 lbs, Bulk \$64.50-70, High Dressing \$71.50.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-7 yrs old, 925-1410 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$760-910.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-6 yrs old, 1120-1250 lbs with 130-200 lbs calves, \$980-1250 per pair. Δ
