Receipts: 460; Last Week: 673; Year Ago: 456

Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold \$1-4 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$5 higher and bulls sold \$8 higher; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 34 percent of the run, 66 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 47 percent of the offering, 43 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 22 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 300-350 lbs \$141-149; 350-400 lbs \$147-159; 400-500 lbs \$129-153; 500-600 lbs \$116-125.50; 600-700 lbs \$110-120.50; few 700-725 lbs \$113-117.50. Medium 2: Pkg 285 lbs \$130; 400-500 lbs \$124-134.50; pkg 528 lbs \$115.50.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 257 lbs \$97.50; pkg 385 lbs \$87.50; pkg 420 lbs \$86.75; pkg 505 lbs \$80; pkg 652 lbs \$79.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 350-400 lbs \$123-133; few 400-475 lbs \$120-131; 500-550 lbs \$112.50-122.50; 550-600 lbs \$105-116.50; 600-700 lbs \$104-114.50;

pkg 815 lbs \$100; pkg 1035 lbs \$93. Medium 2: Few 325-350 lbs \$105-110; few 450-500 lbs \$108.50-113; pkg 680 lbs \$100.25.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium 2: Few 550-575 lbs \$110.50-122.50; pkg 602 lbs \$110.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$58.25-65.25, High Dressing \$71-75.50, Low Dressing few at \$79.50-80; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$59.50-66, High Dressing \$68-72, Low Dressing \$55.50; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$48-54, High Dressing \$58-60, Low Dressing \$43.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1350-1985 lbs, Bulk \$70-78.50, High Dressing \$80.50-84.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 3-7 yrs old, 975-1180 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$790-910.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Very few 4-6 yrs old, 940-1150 lbs with 80-140 lb calves, \$900-1110 per pair. Δ
