Compared to last week, steers over 600 lbs sold \$2 higher, the rest of the offering sold steady to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$1-2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 49 percent of the offering, 46 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 18 percent.
