Receipts: 502; Last Week: 565; Year Ago: 417

Compared to last week, steers sold \$2-10 lower. Slaughter cows sold \$2 lower and bulls sold steady; Demand and supply light. Cows made up approximately 19 percent of the run, 81 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 34 percent of the offering, 55 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 24 percent.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$75-78, High Dressing \$79.75-82.25; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$70.25-77, High Dressing \$78.25-80.25, Low Dressing \$65-68; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$58-63.50, High Dressing \$67.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: 1135-1895 lbs, \$85.25-89.50, High Dressing \$90-92.25.

STOCKER COWS: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-7 yrs old, 960-1135 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$1000-1025.

COW-CALF PAIRS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 4-6 yrs old, 1085-1180 lbs with 125-170 lbs calves, \$1300-1450 per pair. Δ
