Compared to last week, steers sold \$4-6 lower, heifers sold steady to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows sold steady and bulls sold \$6 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 23 percent of the run, 77 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 32 percent of the offering, 49 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 12 percent.
