Receipts: 456; Last Week: 325; Year Ago: 443

Compared to last week, steers sold \$5-8 higher; heifers sold uneven, higher to \$4 lower. Slaughter cows and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 17 percent of the run, 83 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 49 percent of the offering, 47 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 20 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 300-400 lbs \$126-138.50; 400-450 lbs \$125-134; 450-500 lbs \$115.50-125; 500-600 lbs \$114-125; few 600-700 lbs \$108-117.50; 700-725 lbs \$105.50-112. Medium 2: Few 375-400 lbs \$115-123; few 425-450 lbs \$110.50-114.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 424 lbs \$89.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 250-300 lbs \$118-124; few 300-350 lbs \$115-124; few 350-400

lbs \$110-117; 400-500 lbs \$105-116; 500-600 lbs \$102-112; few 600-675 lbs \$97.50-106. Medium 2: Few 300-400 lbs \$105.50-113; few 500-600 lbs \$98-105.50; 650-700 lbs \$90.25-94.75.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 525-600 lbs \$99-113.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$56.25-60, High Dressing few \$61; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$54-59, High Dressing \$60.50-61.75; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$46.50-53.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1165-1540 lbs, bulk \$65-68.75.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Scarce.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 5-7 yrs old, 1010-1230 lbs 2nd and 3rd stage, \$760-880.
