Compared to last week, steers and heifers sold uneven, from \$1 higher to \$2 lower on a very limited test. Slaughter cows and bulls sold \$2 higher; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 24 percent of the run, 76 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 46 percent of the offering, 54 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 26 percent.
