Receipts: 370; Last Week: 503; Year Ago: 415

Compared to last week, the steer offering not well tested, heifers sold steady to \$3 higher. Slaughter cows sold \$1 higher and bulls sold steady; Demand uneven and supply light. Cows made up approximately 16 percent of the run, 84 percent feeders. Steers made up approximately 44 percent of the offering, 46 percent heifers. Offerings over 600 lbs totaled around 32 percent.

FEEDER STEERS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 350-375 lbs \$96-105; pkg 407 lbs \$94.50; 500-600 lbs \$80.50-90.50; pkg 957 lbs \$75.25. Medium and Large 2: Few 350-400 lbs \$90-98; 425-500 lbs \$85-90.

FEEDER HOLSTEINS: Large 3: Pkg 300 lbs \$60; few 400-450 lbs \$58.50-62.25; pkg 640 lbs \$52.75; pkg 863 lbs \$47.50; pkg 958 lbs \$51.50.

FEEDER HEIFERS: Medium and Large 1-2: 350-375 lbs \$83-88; 400-500 lbs \$80-91; 500-600 lbs \$82.50-90.50; 600-675 lbs \$74.25-82.50; few 800-900 lbs \$70.25-71.

Medium 2: Pkg 250 lbs \$89; 400-500 lbs \$75-85.50; 500-550 lbs \$73-80; 600-650 lbs \$70-74; pkg 780 lbs \$67.50.

FEEDER BULLS: Medium 1: Pkg 440 lbs \$82.50-89.50; few 500-550 lbs \$81-89; 600-650 lbs \$75-78.50. Medium 2: Few 450-500 lbs \$80-80.25; few 500-600 lbs \$80-85.50; few 650-700 lbs \$70.

SLAUGHTER COWS: Breaking 75-80 Percent Lean, few \$34-40.25, High Dressing few \$43-44.50; Boning 80-85 Percent Lean, \$35.50-40, High Dressing \$41.25-42, Low Dressing \$32; Lean 85-90 Percent Lean, few \$30-33.

SLAUGHTER BULLS: Yield Grade 1-2: Few 1330-2160 lbs, bulk \$46-50.50, High Dressing \$52, Low Dressing \$40.

STOCKER COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 985-1275 lbs \$39.50-41.50.

REPLACEMENT COWS: Medium and Large 1-2: Few 8 yrs to short and solid mouth, 930-1185 lbs, 2nd and 3rd stage, \$500-560.
